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NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the annual general meeting of the shareholders of Chong Hing Bank Limited (the "Bank") for the year of 2012 will be held on the 27th Floor, Chong Hing Bank Centre, 24 Des Voeux Road Central, Hong Kong on Wednesday, 9 May 2012 at 11:15 am for the purposes of conducting the following items of ordinary and special business:

Ordinary business

As ordinary business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass ordinary resolutions in respect of the following matters:

- (1) To receive and adopt the Financial Statements and the Reports of the Directors and Auditors for the year ended 31 December 2011.
- (2) To declare the final cash dividend for the year ended 31 December 2011.
- (3) To re-elect directors and fix their and the other directors' fee.
- (4) To re-appoint auditors and authorise the directors to fix the auditors' remuneration.

Special business

As special business, to consider and, if thought fit, pass, with or without modification, the following ordinary resolutions:

(5) THAT

- (a) subject to and conditional upon the Listing Committee of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited granting the approval for the listing of, and permission to deal in, the ordinary shares in the capital of the Bank (the "Shares") or any part thereof to be issued pursuant to the exercise of any options that may be granted under the share option scheme ("New Share Option Scheme"), the rules of which are summarised in the circular of the Bank issued on 28 March 2012 and contained in the document marked "A" produced to this meeting and initialed by the Chairman of the meeting for the purpose of identification, the New Share Option Scheme be and is hereby approved and adopted by the Bank; and
- (b) the directors of the Bank be and are hereby authorised to grant options to subscribe for Shares thereunder and to allot, issue and deal with any Shares pursuant to the exercise of the subscription rights under any options which may be granted from time to time in accordance with the terms of the New Share Option Scheme and to do all such acts as they may in their absolute discretion consider necessary or expedient in order to give full effect to the New Share Option Scheme.

(6) **THAT**

- (a) the exercise by the directors during the Relevant Period of all the powers of the Bank to purchase Shares, subject to and in accordance with all applicable laws, be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the aggregate nominal amount of Shares which may be purchased on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited or any other stock exchange recognised for this purpose by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited under the Hong Kong Code on Share Repurchases pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a) above shall not exceed 10 per cent of the aggregate nominal amount of Shares in issue at the date of the passing of this resolution, and the said approval be and is hereby limited accordingly; and
- (c) for the purpose of this resolution:

"Relevant Period" means the period from the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

- (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Bank;
- (ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Bank is required by law to be held; or
- (iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given under this resolution by ordinary resolution of the shareholders in general meeting.

"Shares" means shares of all classes in the capital of the Bank including, without limitation, shares of HK\$0.50 each of the Bank.

(7) **THAT**

- (a) subject to paragraph (c), the exercise by the directors of the Bank during the Relevant Period of all the powers of the Bank to allot, issue and deal with additional shares in the capital of the Bank and to make or grant offers, agreements and options which might require the exercise of such powers be and is hereby generally and unconditionally approved;
- (b) the approval in paragraph (a) shall authorise the directors of the Bank during the Relevant Period to make or grant offers, agreements and options which would or might require the exercise of such power after the end of the Relevant Period;
- (c) the aggregate nominal amount of share capital allotted or agreed conditionally or unconditionally to be allotted (whether pursuant to an option or otherwise) by the directors of the Bank pursuant to the approval in paragraph (a), otherwise than pursuant to (i) any Rights Issue, (ii) any scrip dividend or similar arrangement providing for the allotment and issue of shares in lieu of the whole or part of a dividend on shares of the Bank in accordance with the Articles of Association of the Bank, or (iii) any exercise of options granted under any share option scheme of the Bank, shall not exceed the aggregate of:
 - (aa) 20 per cent of the aggregate nominal amount of the shares in the capital of the Bank in issue at the date of the passing of this resolution; and
 - (bb) (if the directors are so authorised by a separate ordinary resolution of the shareholders of the Bank) the nominal amount of any share capital of the Bank repurchased by the Bank subsequent to the passing of this resolution,

and the said approval be and is hereby limited accordingly; and

(d) for the purpose of this resolution:

"Relevant Period" means the period from the passing of this resolution until whichever is the earliest of:

(i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Bank;

(ii) the expiration of the period within which the next annual general meeting of the Bank is

required by law to be held; or

(iii) the revocation or variation of the authority given under this resolution by ordinary resolution of

the shareholders in general meeting.

"Rights Issue" means an offer of shares open for a period fixed by the directors of the Bank to

holders of shares of the Bank or any class thereof on the register on a fixed record date in proportion

to their then holdings of such shares or class thereof (subject to such exclusion or other arrangements

as the directors of the Bank may deem necessary or expedient in relation to fractional entitlements or having regard to any restrictions or obligations under the laws of, or the requirements of any

recognised regulatory body or any stock exchange in, any territory outside Hong Kong).

(8) **THAT** the directors of the Bank be and are hereby authorised to exercise the powers of the Bank referred to

in paragraph (a) of the resolution set out as Resolution 7 in the notice convening this meeting in respect

of the share capital of the Bank referred to in sub-paragraph (bb) of paragraph (c) of that resolution.

Any other ordinary business

(9) To transact other ordinary business (if any).

- (i) A shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the 2012 annual general meeting of the shareholders is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote in his stead. A proxy does not have to be a shareholder of the Bank. Forms of proxy are to be lodged with the registered office of the Bank at Ground Floor, Chong Hing Bank Centre, 24 Des Voeux Road Central, Hong Kong not later than 48 hours before the time for the holding of the 2012 annual general meeting of the shareholders and any adjournment thereof.
- (ii) For the purpose of ascertaining the Shareholders who are entitled to attend and vote at the 2012 annual general meeting of the shareholders, the register of members of the Bank will be closed from Thursday, 3 May 2012 to Friday, 4 May 2012 (both days inclusive), during which period no transfer of shares can be registered.
